The Embassy of Nepal in Beijing hosted a reception to mark the 262nd Raising Day of the Nepali Army at the Embassy premises this evening.

Welcoming the guests in the event, H.E. Colonel KC expressed confidence that these collaborative engagements would continue to enhance regional peace, stability, and foster deeper bilateral trust between Nepal and its international partners.

Over 200 guests including government officials, high-ranking officials from the People's Liberation Army, members of the Beijing Military Attaché Corps, defence attaches and members of the diplomatic corps, and representatives from the Nepali community in China were present in the programme.
