




Health Facilities Reporting Status 2080/81 (%)



Immunization Coverage




Trend of Vaccine Wastage Rate (%)



Average Number of People Served by Health Facilities /Day (2080/81)




% of newborns with low birth weight (<2.5kg) among total delivery by HWs




Average number of visits among children aged 0-23 months registered for growth monitoring



Trend of Pregnant Women who Received 180 Tablets of Iron (%)





Incidence of Pneumonia and Diarrhea under five-year children (Per 1000 Children)




Treatment of Pneumonia and Diarrhea under five-year children





Trend of Pregnant Women Who Attended Eight ANC Visits as Per Protocol (%)





District wise Pregnant Women Who Attended Eight ANC Visits as Per Protocol FY 2080/81(%)




Mothers who had Three PNC Check-up as Per Protocol (%)




Status of Safe Abortion Service (%)

Trend of pregnant women receiving abortion service




Trend of women who received contraceptives after abortion




Status of Family Planning Service (%)

Trend of Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (%)




District Wise Status of Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (%)




Annual parasite incidence (API) per 1000 population risk




Trend of Malaria Cases (N)



Trend of Dengue Cases (N)





Trend of Kala-azar Cases (N)




New Case Detection Rate of Leprosy






Prevalence of leprosy per 10000 Population







HIV TESTING AND COUNSELLING (by age group)








Trend of Bed Occupancy Rate (%)



Trend of Average Length of Stay at Hospital (Days)


