The Government of Nepal provided relief materials as humanitarian assistance to the Government and people of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar in the aftermath of devastating earthquake. Approximately twenty seven tonnes relief materials which included medicines, food, water, tents, blankets, sleeping bags, mosquito nets, and other essential supplies were sent via chartered flight RNA-4015(A-330) today.

On behalf of the Government of Nepal, Mr. Tapas Adhikari, Head of Southeast Asia and Pacific Division, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Mr. Harishchandra Ghimire, Ambassador of Nepal to Myanmar handed over the relief materials to Ambassador U Wai Linn, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Myanmar at Nay Pyi Taw International Airport. Briefing the Nepali delegation on casualties, injuries, infrastructural damages, and ongoing search and recovery operations, Ambassador Mr. Linn thanked the Government and people of Nepal for the support at this critical hour of need. Mr. Adhikari conveyed condolences and sympathies on loss of lives and properties incurred due to earthquake, extended best wishes for the speedy recovery of injured people, and expressed solidarity of the Government and people of Nepal with the Government and people of Myanmar.

The Nepali delegation comprising of officials from Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Home Affairs, National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority, Nepali media personnel, and officials from Government of Myanmar were present in the handing over ceremony.
