On the auspicious occasion of the 2569th Buddha Jayanti marking the International Day of Vesak, the Embassy of Nepal in the Kingdom of Bahrain in collaboration with the Nepali Community Groups in Bahrain successfully organized a program on Monday, 12 May 2025. The celebration offers an opportunity to reflect on the Buddha's profound journey and teachings, which emphasize compassion, wisdom, and the path to peace.

The program commenced with butter lamp lighting and invocation of blessings. H.E. Mr. Tirtha Raj Wagle, Ambassador of Nepal to the Kingdom of Bahrain, H.E. Mr. Vinod K.
