Notice

Foreign journalists or media personnel intending to engage in any form of journalistic or news dissemination activities within the territory of Nepal are required to obtain a Press Representative Certificate /Identification Card from the Department of Information and Broadcasting, in accordance with the legally prescribed procedures.


As per the prevailing laws, regulations, and media policies of the Government of Nepal, any media activity undertaken without obtaining the said identification card shall be considered unauthorized. The concerned authorities reserve the right to monitor and take appropriate legal measures in response to such actions.

Accordingly, all foreign journalists and media professionals are advised to contact the Department of Information and Broadcasting-either prior to arrival in Nepal or immediately upon entry-to obtain the legally required Press Representative Certificate and Identification Card.

Journalistic or media activities conducted without this official authorization shall not be legally recognized, and individuals involved may be subject to action under the existing legal framework of Nepal.

The Government of Nepal remains firmly committed to press freedom. Nevertheless, such freedom must be exercised within the bounds of the host country's legal and regulatory framework, and in accordance with international standards of professional conduct.
